Pinot Rosé NV Brut Spumante, Le Contesse, Italy (11.0%)

Delicate blend of Pinots Grigio, Bianco and Chardonnay grapes from Valdobbiandene. It has a subtle pink colour with shades of violet. Persistent and fine bubble with a full, rich palate. Will do equally as well as an aperitif or with light terrines and parfais.

Prosecco NV Extra Dry, Porta Leone, Italy (11.0%)

Made from Glera grapes from Treviso by 3 generations of the same family headed by 85-year-old Olimpia. Ripe apple and pears on the nose, beautiful, steady, pinhead bubble finishing lifted and zesty. More character and flavour than many less carefully made styles.

Pinot Meunier based Champagne. Mellow, rounded, sumptuous, biscuity, balanced, lemony and complex style of Champagne. It represents everything we love about smaller, less known, champagne houses and we are not the only one as it won a bronze medal at the International Wine Challenge in 2015.

Poi Roger Brut Reserve NV, Champagne (12.5%)

£75.00

Winston Churchill favoured this brand, and as far as we are concerned it is the best of all the big names after Krug. Not only is the wine of the highest quality from a majority of Pinot Noir grapes, it also spends a minimum of 3 years in one of the coolest and deepest cellar in the Champagne region, extending 7km under the city of Epernay, helping create the famously fine bubbles.

The "ginniest" of gins with a higher concentration of juniper than any other brand, although only 12 people in the world know the full distillation process for Gordon's	
Bombay Sapphire Gin (40.0%)	£3.50
Created using the vapour infusion process where 10 botanicals are held separate from the spirit in perforated copper baskets, and when the vapours rise, the distinctive flavours of the botanicals are released.	
Bloom Premium London Dry Gin (40.0%)	£3.50
Delicate and floral and inspired by the natural flora of an English country garden. Chamomile, pomelo and honeysuckle were chosen the key three botanicals.	
Tanqueray No 10 Gin (47.3%)	£4.10
Named after the Tiny 10 still in which it is distilled four times, it is the only gin to be handcrafted with fresh citrus fruits (grapefruit, orange and limes) along with camomile flowers and other hand selected botanicals.	
Whitley Neil London Dry Gin (TBC)	£4.50
Sweet citrus peel, peppery spice and floral aromas with a smooth, rich juniper, pot pourri and exotic spice on the palate. Features the wild citrus fruit of the African Baobab tree and physalis amongst its nine botanicals.	

Modern

Hendrick's Gin (41.4%)	£4.10
Smooth with character and a balance of subtle flavours. Infusions of rose petals and cucumber create a wonderfully refreshing gin with floral aroma. Made in Ayrshire using antique stills, in tiny 450 litres batches.	
Beefeater 24 Gin (45.0%)	£4.50
A fragrant gin with good sweetness. 12 ingredients including Japanese Sencha tea, coriander seeds, liquorice, angelica root, almond and orris root are used to produce this gin. The botanicals are steeped in the spirit for a full 24 hours giving it its name.	
Monkey 47 Schwarzwald Dry Gin (47.0%)	£4.90
Of German origin with a distinct scent of citrus and lavender notes, a scent of pure juniper, a floral aroma and a hint of peppery spices. One for the gin lovers with its deep and harmonious complexity. 47 ingredients including cranberries.

A unique tribute to George Smith’s vision to create the definitive smooth Speyside malt. Smooth fruity flavour.

Glenfiddich 12 Year Old Special Reserve (40.0%) ○ £4.30

A single malt with distinctive fresh pear, creamy with subtle oak flavours and a long smooth and mellow finish.

Highland

Glenmorangie – The Original (43.0%) ● £4.30

A 10 Year Old single malt, elegant and floral. A mature spirit that is soft, mellow and creamy.

Highland park 12 Year Old (40.0%) ● £5.00

The most northerly Scotch whisky distillery. Rich with subtle, almost floral smoke. Very distinctive.

Jura Origin 10 Year Old (40.0%) ● £4.60

From the island of Jura, off the western coast of Scotland. Soft hints of honey, caramel and soft liquorice and perfect sipped as a pre-dinner aperitif.

Dalwhinnie 15 Year Old (43.0%) ● £7.00

From the highest working distillery in Scotland. Often described as the perfect Highland single malt with its good balance of heather-honey sweetness and intensity

Lowland

Auchentoshan 12 Year Old (40.0%) ● £7.00

Triple distilled and matured for over 12 years. Stylish, contemporary, light and subtle. A great single malt.

Islay

Laphroaig 10 Year Old (40.0%) ● £6.00

A bold, smoky taste followed by a hint of seaweed and a surprising sweetness. Distilled in the same way for over 75 years.

Coal Ila 12 Year Old (43.0%) ● £6.00

Pronounced “Cull Eela” means “Sounds of Islay”. A very smooth single malt that is easy-going making a good aperitif.

The Famous Grouse (40.0%) £3.10

Chivas Regal 12 year Old (40.0%) £4.00

Monkey Shoulder (40.0%) £4.60

A blend of 3 malt whiskies from Speyside’s finest distilleries. A contemporary brand for a new generation of whisky drinkers

Other whisky, whiskey, Bourbon

Jameson Irish Whiskey (40.0%) £3.40

Triple distilled, smooth and balanced. It mixes perfectly with ginger ale, lemonade and apple juice

Canadian Club (40.0%) £3.10

The only recognised Canadian Whiskey in the UK. Smooth and highly mixable. Refreshing and smooth with a bright gold colour and aromas of almond nuttiness, complimented with hints of rich oak and sweet vanilla.

Jack Daniel's (40.0%) £3.40

Often mistaken for a Bourbon, it is in fact a Tennessee Whiskey. Charcoal "mellowed" to give it its distinct smooth flavour, well rounded and balanced with a pleasant mix of caramel, vanilla and wood flavours.

Jim Beam White (40.0%) £3.40

One of the best known brand of American Bourbon, named after Colonel James B. Beam who rebuilt the business following Prohibition. Aged for four years in oak barrels to create a smooth and mellow taste with hints of spice.


Jim Beam Red Stag Black Cherry (40.0%) £4.00

Derived from Jim Beam Original and infused with natural flavours.

Wild Turkey 81 (40.5%) £4.00

81 proof Bourbon aged for 6 to 8 years, a bold, in-your-face taste distinctive of Wild Turkey. On the palate you get a spicy kick with almonds, honey and blackberries

Cognac

“V.S.” means that the youngest eau de vie used in a blend must spend at least 2 years in cask, “V.S.O.P” at least four years, “X.O.” at least 10 years.

Martell V.S. (40.0%) **£3.30**

Wood and spice notes combined with a pleasant freshness. Enjoy neat or as a long drink with ginger ale or tonic water.

Courvoisier V.S. (40.0%) **£3.30**

Golden colour with a bouquet of ripe fruit and spring flowers.

Rémy Martin V.S.O.P. Mature Cask Finish (40.0%) **£5.50**

Made from grapes grown in the most sought after areas of Cognac – Grande Champagne and Petite champagne – achieving a well rounded and perfectly balanced Cognac

Hennessy X.O. (40.0%) **£ 13.50**

First created in 1870 for Maurice Hennessy's personal use. The ageing process developed aromas of leather, oak and black pepper, with vanilla and cardamom notes.

Vodka

Smirnoff No.21 (Red) (37.5%) **£3.10**

The No 1 selling vodka in the world, triple distilled and 10 times filtered

Russian Standard (40.0%) **£3.10**

Made only in St. Petersburg, this is the benchmark for excellence in the homeland of vodka

Chase Potato Vodka (40.0%) **£4.60**

The first and only British Potato Vodka, voted World's Best at the San Francisco Spirit Competition.

Chase Rhubarb Vodka (40.0%) **£4.60**

Made without artificial ingredients, achieving a natural scent of rhubarb with subtle sweetness

Grey Goose L'Original (40.0%) **£4.80**

Oh la la! French vodka with a clean, fresh and elegant floral aroma. Initially soft on the palate with a gentle sweetness that gradually envelops the mouth into a smooth and rounded texture.

Stolichnaya Vodka (40.0%) **£3.60**

A classic style, exceptionally smooth vodka. In 1972, the PepsiCo company struck a barter agreement with the government of the Soviet Union. PepsiCo would have the western market exportation rights of Stolichnaya in exchange for importation and Soviet marketing of Pepsi-Cola. This led to Pepsi-Cola being the first American consumer product to be produced, marketed and sold in the U.S.S.R.

The original premium aged white rum first produced in 1862 in Santiago de Cuba.	
The Kraken Black Spiced Rum (40.0%)	£3.80
Produced using rums from Trinidad & Tobago, aged 12 to 24 month and blended with 11 spices. Strong, rich, black and smooth.	
Sailor Jerry (40.0%)	£3.50
An enduring classic honouring the legacy of Norman 'Sailor Jerry' Collins. Its smoothness is the result of skilled blenders using a unique recipe	
Captain Morgan Original Dark Rum (40.0%)	£3.10
The original dark spiced rum. The mellow spices that are brought out in the maturation process give it an unmistakably legendary flavour	
Bundaberg Under Proof Rum (37.0%)	£3.50
Founded in 1888, the brand is famous throughout the world and has a fanatical following in its native Australia	
Pyrat XO Reserve (40.0%)	£5.00
Golden blend of fine 15-year-old Caribbean rums, excellent over ice with a twist of lemon.
